## Youth Basketball Leagues: Grades 3 through 8

Early Bird Registration Rates available through November 8th: \$80.00 per player

Registrations will be accepted through November 22<sup>nd</sup>: \$100.00 per player

\*\*Registrations submitted after evaluations have taken place will be considered first come first serve dependent on number of players and teams\*\*

League play is designed to give Portland children the opportunity to experience and enjoy the game of basketball in a fun and encouraging environment. Each team will be scheduled one practice and game per week. All players will receive a team shirt. Leagues are **NOT** co-ed. You must be a Portland resident and registered with the Portland Parks & Recreation Department to participate on a team.

Practices and games will be an integral part of every grade's league. These different types of play are intended to provide all participants with an overview of the basic rules of basketball and to help develop their skills as an individual and as a team. Players will be distributed into teams following the pre-season evaluations.

- Grades 3 through 4
  - o Score will NOT be kept in these beginner games and all games will tentatively be played in Portland
- Grades 5 through 8
  - o Score WILL be kept and some games will be played out of town (dependent upon enrollment)

Player evaluations are highly recommended and attendance is encouraged for all individuals who plan to participate in Youth Basketball. These evaluations give us the best opportunity to see all players demonstrate their abilities and then distribute them to create the most fair and evenly skilled teams possible. Even though we call it an evaluation, the main objective is to get the players into the gym, play basketball, and have some fun! Players who cannot attend evaluations will still be placed on a team. 
Come and enjoy Portland's Weekend of Holiday Happenings for the Family!
